
145 Attacks on U-Boats In Month Listed by BBC

In a broadcast directed to German seamen and picked up by the Columbia Broadcasting System yesterday, the British Broadcasting Company said that "in the twenty-four hours up to Thursday midnight five attacks were made on German U-boats in the Atlantic by destroyers, corvettes and planes of the Atlantic patrol, and during the whole of September 145 attacks were made on German U-boats in the Atlantic."

There were 130 attacks in August, and the commentator added: "We are satisfied to note from time to time that our attacks on German U-boats are increasing to an encouraging degree."

Explaining why no information is given as to submarines actually sunk, BBC said: "We like to keep Admiral Doenitz [German submarine commander] guessing until he can find out himself."
